

# *Rollerama* at Bunjil Place





This is Bunjil Place.  
You will see a sign for  
Bunjil Place.



The front area of Bunjil Place is called the Plaza. You will see a white tent. Inside is the Rollerama rink.



You will see a staff member in a blue t-shirt under a little marquee. They may say hello. This is where you sanitise your hands.



The next step to do to check in for COVID tracing. You will see a QR code near the sanitiser. Your grown up will check in for you.



After you check in, there will be a pop up black tent with friendly staff there. They will greet you. This is where you show your tickets. If you do not have tickets, you can buy them here.



After collecting your tickets, follow the blue circles on the ground next to the white tent to the entry way for *Rollerama*.



There will be staff with a scanner to scan your ticket. They may ask you to sanitise your hands again.





You can say hello to the staff. If you have any questions, you can ask them.



You will sit on the red bench. The staff will ask you (or your grown up) your shoe size. This size will help them get the right roller-skates to fit your feet.



You will take off your shoes. If you need help, you can ask your grown up or a staff member.



A staff member will take your shoes and put it on the shelf.



A staff member will give you your roller-skates. You will put them on. If you need help, you can ask your grown up or a staff member.



Inside the tent is a big red rink. This is where you will roller-skate. There may be other people using it too. You will need to share the rink.

## Safety and Rink Rules

- Skaters must have a shoe size of greater than child size 9
- Children must not be left unattended
- No Food or Drinks on rink
- Skates only allow on rink
- Parents & Spectators must stay outside of fenced area
- No games allowed on rink
- No racing on rink
- We accept no liability for injury or damage to skaters on the rink
- Keep head up, eyes forward
- Pick up each foot to move forward
- Glide with feet in a parallel position
- Skate at a moderate and controllable speed
- Skaters should not lay on ground and should get up quickly after a fall

When you are inside the Rollerama, it is important to know the rules. You will follow the rules so you can enjoy your visit and have fun.



The staff member will tell you 'One more lap' which means you can do one more lap, then you will finish rollerskating.





You will take off your roller-skates. You can ask your grown up or a staff member to help you. You will put your shoes back on.



To go out, you will leave the tent the way you came in.
