## HOW TO GET HERE

Bunjil Place is located on Patrick Northeast Drive Narre Warren.

### BY CAR

You can get to us via the Monash and South Gippsland Freeways and the Princes Highway. We're no more than half an hour from Frankston, Ringwood, Pakenham and the middle-ring suburbs, and an easy 40 minutes on the M1 from the CBD.

### BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Jump on the Pakenham Line to Narre Warren Station. We're a 15 minute stroll or short local bus ride to Westfield Fountain Gate, just down the road. For more info visit Public Transport Victoria's website.

## PARKING

There are a range of free parking options available at Bunjil Place, including all-day and accessible parking.

Please note that due to the diversity of facilities and activities taking place across the precinct, at peak periods parking may not be available in the immediate proximity of Bunjil Place. To avoid a rushed experience, we strongly advise that you plan your arrival time at least 15 minutes prior to your session time to allow for finding a park, making your way into the venue and through the cloak before making your way to the Gallery.


