

Bus Subsidy Terms and Conditions

1. Subsidies are available for City of Casey schools and schools in the southeastern Victoria region [DET MAP-Regions_3.5.19 \(education.vic.gov.au\)](#)
2. Schools with an ICSEA (Index of Community Socio-Educational Advantage) rating below 1028 are eligible to apply for this subsidy.
3. Subsidies will only be granted for activities and events that are programmed by Bunjil Place such as exhibitions and Bunjil Presents performances.
4. Applications are assessed on their merit by a nominated representative of Bunjil Place Creative Communities team and in order of receipt. Subsidies will be granted until the full subsidy fund has been allocated.
5. All decisions regarding the allocation of subsidies are final and no discussion will be entered into regarding those decisions.
6. If school cancellations occur, bus subsidies must be used as early as is convenient and recommended within the current year of the subsidy. If this cannot be arranged the subsidy is to be used in the next calendar year.
7. If the performance and/or event is cancelled by Bunjil Place, the education team will inform schools as soon as possible so you can cancel your bus booking. The subsidy can be used for a future education program in agreement with Bunjil Place.
